LABELLING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITH A PREGNANCY HEALTH
ADVISORY LABEL**

The Dietitians Association of Australia (DAA) supports Option 2 of Application A576 to amend the Code to require a health advisory label on alcoholic beverage containers advising of the risk of consuming alcohol when planning to become pregnant and during pregnancy. DAA believes that there is sufficient evidence to warrant such labeling in order to protect a vulnerable group in the Australian population. Furthermore, this initiative is consistent with the draft NHMRC document – *Australian Alcohol Guidelines for Low-risk Drinking*.
