

## Accreditation Fee Structure

*Effective January 2011\**

Accreditation Phase	Fee for universities with one program	Fee for universities with two or more programs
Application for Provisional Accreditation is for new dietetic programs. The provisional Accreditation report is due 18 months prior to the completion of studies of the first cohort of students.	\$30 000 with a \$5000 discount for reports received by the due date	50% levy for each additional program
Full Accreditation is due within 24 months of the first graduates completing the program. The report is due 12 months prior to this date.	\$25 000 with a \$5000 discount for reports received by the due date	50% levy for each additional program
Re-Accreditation is due within five years of the last full accreditation. The report is due 12 months prior to this date.	\$25 000 with a \$5000 discount for reports received by the due date	50% levy for each additional program
Interim Accreditation Reports are required to inform DAA of any significant changes with staff or programming and may be completed at any time.	No Fee	No Fee

\*Fees may be increased annually to reflect CPI increases.

Fees are payable at the time of submission of the first report related to the accreditation for which the University has applied.
